The 2013 vintage, Leviathan's tenth bottling, is a concentrated wine with outstanding finesse and complexity. Andy looks to maximize the expression of some of the most sought-after vineyards in California to create a distinctive and compelling blend.

The 2013 Selections:

- 37 % Cabernet Sauvignon from Oakville, Coombsville, Dry Creek, & Lake County.

Volcanic soils and high elevations with slopes up to thirty degrees create exceptional growing conditions. Vineyards include Daviana Estate, which produces some of the most coveted Cabernet Sauvignon grapes in California

- 32% Syrah from Carneros, Amador County, Lake County, & Dry Creek

The Hudson Vineyards enjoy cooling winds from San Francisco Bay, creating slow- ripening conditions, as does the high elevations of the Obsidian Ridge plantings

- 24% Merlot from Carneros

The Merlot grapes are sourced from low-yield, meticulously farmed vineyards including the famous Hudson Ranch vineyard, using organic and bio-diverse growing practices

- 7% Cabernet Franc from Carneros, Eastern Vaca Mountains of Napa, & Oakville.

Oakville Ranch vineyards boast the red volcanic soil that produces bold tannins and rich color of these grapes
