Sourced from our estates, Camp Meeting Ridge and Sea View Ridge, as well as a number of long-term grower partners on the Sonoma Coast.

TASTING NOTES

Floral expressions of lilac and fresh roses. Flavors of Santa Rosa plum and cranberry. Notes of cedar and baking spice linger for a long, savory finish.

WINEMAKING

Crafted with minimal intervention in the cellar. Fermented using 100% native yeast. Aged in 100% French Oak (20% new) for 10 months.
