Tasting Notes: Garnet core. Engaging notes of raspberry, cranberry and orange zest are complemented by baking spices and forest floor with notes of hibiscus and dried tea leaf. The palate is expressive, blending richness and elegance with a smooth entry, fine grained tannins and flavors of pomegranate and clove. Woven together with tension and verve, the minerality and coastal acidity highlight the long finish.

Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaking: Fermented with 100% native yeast in small, opentop stainless steel tanks. The wine is aged in 100% French Oak (30% new) for 18 months.

Vineyards: Sourced 100% from our Camp Meeting Ridge Estate vineyard on the extreme Sonoma Coast.
